Relief Kits for Haiti are being assembled, following is a list of contents. These kits are due Sunday, February 14th.

Relief Kits: (New items only)

4 large bars bath soap (leave in wrapping)
1 plastic bottle shampoo (380-710ml/13-24oz; place bottle in a re-sealable plastic bag)
4 large bars laundry soap (some stores carry FelsNaptha, Sunlight or Zote brands, contact local MCC w/ questions)
1 squeeze-tube toothpaste (minimum 130 ml/6 oz; leave in box)
4 adult-size toothbrushes (leave in packaging)
4 bath towels (medium weight, not light colored)
2 wide tooth combs (15-20 cm/6-8 in)
1 fingernail clipper
1 box adhesive bandages (minimum 40, assorted)
1 package sanitary pads (18-24 thin maxi)

Place contents in a box or bag. The kit will be repacked in a new 5 gallon plastic pail with lid. **IMPORTANT:** Please follow instructions carefully. Limit your generosity to the contents listed.
