Our Pastoral Discernment Committee met on June 1. After a devotional focused on unity from Phillipians 2 led by Ron Horst, we began our discussion of various models for our future leadership. However we felt it would be valuable to have some additional leadership from the outside for a period while the gifts in our congregation are encouraged and grown. We agreed it would be valuable to bring in a part-time interim Pastor to assist with some of the Pastoral work and to support us in identifying and utilizing the gifts among us. We will be meeting again on June 23. A brief job description developed for our needs follows:

The New Danville Mennonite Church is looking for a part-time interim pastor to serve within their congregation for a minimum of two years (no longer than three), as of August 2010. We are seeking leadership that will help our congregation move forward into God's preferred future as we develop leadership and other gifts within the congregation, continue the process of implementing a new church structure, and engage in ministry within our church body, in the local community, and in the world at large.
